Dear Sponsors;

Once again warm greeting from Goa, the land of sand, sea and sun. It is always a pleasure to provide you with the latest information about our organisation. We feel happy when you are in touch with the progress, achievements and expansion of Indian Students Educational Aid Foundation.

This year many students applied for scholarship. After thoroughly scrutinizing their applications, we interviewed many deserving students and found around 200 students very deserving. Till date we could give scholarship to 112 students, thanks to our sponsors. We are grateful to all our sponsors who recommended to their friends for sponsoring such students. Still many students are in the waiting list. We will be extremely thankful if you can give the necessary publicity to this and ask your friends and associates to visit our website

So that some of our deserving students can continue their education.

In our technical institute at Palye we appointed a new Principal Mr. Padmanabh Lotlikar in the place of Mr. Prakash Gawas who retired on 31/1/2010. Mr. Lotlikar is a national award winner and found very enthusiastic. He has already started visiting schools of the catchments area and is trying to get maximum number of dropout students for the next academic year. In Siolim the technical institute functions very well under the leadership of Principal Mr. S. G. Sawant. Some firms already approached us for campus interview to recruit our students when they complete their courses. This year we started another technical institute at Porvorim 3k.m. away from the capital city of Panaji. "I.S.E.A.F.'s Dasya Institute of Home Nursing". Here we started only home nursing and 26 students are admitted here.

Our Home Nursing Bureau is functioning very well under the leadership of Mrs. Stella Jacob. Presently more than 220 girls are working for this bureau. Though we educate more than hundred students every year not all of them join our bureau. Others go to hospitals and other

establishments. Some of them go to gulf countries where they are paid very well. Since there is a big demand for nurses we are looking forward to start more institutes to train girls to work as Home Nurses.

The orphanage “Valentina’s Little Heaven” is being supported by us continuously. This year we built five toilets, bath rooms and wash basins for the children. This is in addition to the school bus, digging well, fixing over head tank, water supply and a concealed ceiling for the rooms of children to protect them from heat. We are thankful to our sponsors who contributed for Valentina’s Little Heaven and made this possible.

During the visit of Mr. Schwartz in the month of January this year he visited along with the undersigned a school for mentally challenged students called “ATMAVISHWAS” which means ‘Building Confidence’. This institute is at Tuem a remote village in Pernem, few kilometers away from our office. There are 53 students in this institute and they are divided in five classes considering the age of students. They have trained teachers and we felt the children are very happy to be in this school. The management is not having sufficient money and they manage this school with donations. A list of requirement was placed in front of Mr. Schwartz. The list consists of materials, equipments and teaching aids for the children. Mr. Schwartz sanctioned money for the entire list and paid.

We hope and believe that our sponsors are happy with our work. We always welcome your suggestions, queries and your opinions. We believe that this will help us in improving our work.
