Dear Sponsors;

Once again accept our warm greetings. It is indeed our great pleasure to keep you informed about our organization, its activities, progress, expansion and achievements so that you are well informed about ISEAF.

It has been observed that our letters reach sponsors very late. In order to save time and money we decided to send letters and reports through electronic mail here after to all sponsors who got e-mail address. The sponsors who have not given their e-mail address till date are requested to inform their e-mail id so that we will be able to communicate with them faster.

Indian Students Educational Aid Foundation has become very popular and many students applied for scholarship. After interviewing we found many students were deserving for scholarship. This year besides personal interview a team of staff from our office visited each student at his or her residence and found 226 students eligible. But unfortunately there were only 92 vacancies and we were forced to keep 150 students in the waiting list. We gave scholarship to 70 students without any sponsors. It was possible due to donation from a German firm. We hope we will be able to find some new sponsor for these students in the near future. It will be appreciated if you can give publicity among your friends and acquaintants and ask them to visit our website www.iseaf-info.org . A long list of deserving students along with their photograph and other details are displayed in this website.

To expand our Technical Institute at Siolim we are still in the look out of a plot in and around Siolim. But we could not get one till date due to many reasons. Many plots we came across do not have the necessary documents. But still we hope that we will be able to get one in the near future. In Bhumika Technical Institute we appointed Mr. Prakash Gawas as its Administrator. Mr. Gawas was working for the Government of Goa as education officer. He does an excellent job. He met many students who could not continue their education in academic schools. So many students took admission in this institute and all the classes are having good strength.

We feel very proud when we find that most of our students who passed out from Technical Institutes get well paid jobs in India and abroad and are capable of supporting themselves and their family.

One of our sponsored students Prajakta Shigaonkar is staying in an orphanage called Valentina's Little Heaven, in South Goa. We came in contact with this orphanage through Prajakta and visited that house three times and found that Sr. Valentina, who is running this house, is doing a wonderful work. Mr. Rudolf Schwartz founder of ISEAF offered to collect 10.000 Euros to buy a mini bus, so that they can use it for transporting the children to school and without the mini bus it is impossible for the children to reach the school in time. She has 78 orphans staying in her house. In future ISEAF will be working with her providing her whatever help we can.

We want to encourage all the sponsors who want to visit our students. We will be very happy to arrange such meetings. Please feel free to ask any questions regarding your students or about our organization. I assure you that you will get a quick reply soon.

Dinesh is very thankful to his sponsor as well as ISEAF for the financial and moral support he got when it was required very badly in his life.

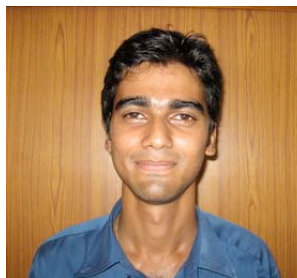
Nazira Khan

Nazira Khan completed her Medical Electronics successfully and presently working. She is very thankful to her sponsor and ISEAF for all the financial assistance and moral support.

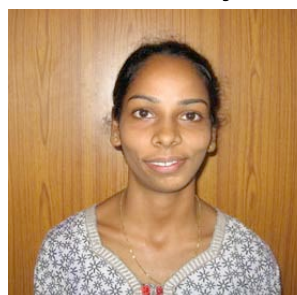
Siddharth Vernekar
