We would like to send our warm greetings to you once more. It is our great pleasure to keep you informed about our organisation so that you will be in touch with us.

Mr. Rudolf Schwartz the founder of our organisation visited us twice. In November he spent 4 weeks and in January 2008 during his second visit he spent 6 weeks with us. He has to do lot of work during this time. Three of our scholarship students became orphans suddenly and we were successful to find sponsors to support them with a monthly family assistance. So that they get sufficient food, cloths and other requirements. Now more than 25 students get such family assistance besides their scholarship from our organisation. We are happy that these students can stay in their own houses and enjoying the company of their neighbours, friends & relatives and avoid spending their life in orphanages.

At present our organisation is functioning very well. All our problems are solved successfully. Hence we can continue our work and help the needy and deserving students. Since it is very necessary to expand our Technical Institute at Siolim we are looking for a plot of land at Siolim. Hope we will be successful soon.

Our Home Nursing Bureau does a wonderful job. Though we train more than 100 nurses every year, we are unable to cope up with the demand from the people. The society in India has been under going great changes in recent years. In the past parents stayed with their children and spent their whole life together. But now many children work abroad leaving their parents in their own house. They are ready to spend money for the service of a home nurse to avoid sending their parents to an old age home. So there is a very big demand for our nurses.

As in the past this year also many sponsors visited our institute to meet their students. The students were very much excited to meet their sponsors. It is a great moment in their life. In case any sponsor wants to meet their students we are extremely happy to arrange such meetings with students.

Our institute became very popular in Goa. Many '**write ups**' appeared about ISEAF in the local newspapers. Goa Television also visited our institute and telecasted our activities in many channels.

All these activities could be possible only through your contribution and encouragement. We are indeed very grateful to you for your generosity and looking forward to your co-operation in future too.

Jaison Franco



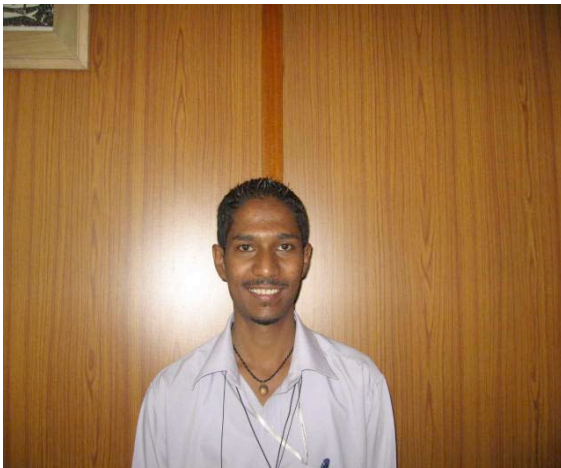

Her neighbours also offered to help the children. But they need money for food, cloths and for their education. ISEAF provided money for their initial expenditure
